Nissan Motor Manufacturing UK (SR5 3NS) Work will largely be with the Outbound Logistics Function based within the NDS office and some time will be required at Port of Tyne.

Flexible but expected to be completed by 31 March 2022 and take between 300 – 400 hours on a flexible part-time basis.

Flexible to work alongside the successful applicant's academic commitments, but NMUK hours are Mon to Thur 8 – 5 and Fri8 – 2.25

About the internship:

The successful applicant will work alongside Nissan Outbound Logistics representatives on a specific project to simulate the flow of Finished Vehicles post manufacture at NMUK through to storage in local compounds (at the Sunderland plant for UK destination vehicles and Port of Tyne for overseas destination vehicles). The intern will conduct research and design new software to either confirm that existing flows are optimised or advise how they could be improved to drive efficiency savings (reduce costs).
